1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to restrict the release or use of social security numbers by
2 the state and its political subdivisions unless certain security measures are taken.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. No state agency or any of its political subdivisions or any official, agent, or
5 employee of any state agency or political subdivision may:

6 (1) Knowingly release or post any person's social security number on the internet or any
7 other media or domain available to the general public; or

8 (2) Require any person to transmit the person's social security number over the internet,
9 unless the connection is secure or the social security number is encrypted; or

10 (3) Require any person to use the person's social security number to access an internet
11 website, unless a password or unique personal identification number or other
12 authentication device is also required to access the internet website.

13 Section 2. As used in this Act, the terms, release, post, and transmit, mean to knowingly
14 communicate or otherwise make available to the general public.
