Subject: Roadkill deer contracts

Aaron,

Here is the information requested the joint appropriations committee earlier this week. Please let me know if you need additional information.

- 24 total contracts statewide; 5 cover county roads only (100% paid by GFP), 19 cover state and federal highways (50:50 paid by GFP and DOT).
- Not all state highways west of the Missouri River are covered by contracts, county road only contracts exist for the Black Hills and east river counties which hold major urban areas.
- Total carcass numbers removed 2007 = 11,997 (DOT cost = \$145,259, GFP cost = \$161,340).
- 19 contracts pay by the carcass (average = \$26.13/carcass, range \$15 - \$65). NOTE - the \$15/carcass contractor just quit his contract at the beginning of this year. Most contract \$/carcass is a set fee, a few change the \$/carcass based on what county the carcass is picked-up from, 2 contracts base the \$/carcass figure on categorical groups of miles from a home base.
- 2 contracts pay based on a set total dollar amount. These contracts are for removals along Interstate 90 and include roadway debris removal.
- Estimated carcass numbers and cost for all current contracts are 14,554 carcasses for \$380,320 (combined GFP/DOT).
