

20:71:01:01. Definitions. Terms used in this article mean:

(1) "Board," the Board of Examiners for Counselors and Marriage and Family Therapists as defined in SDCL 36-33-2;

(2) "Group supervision," the act or process of watching over the training, work experience, and performance of applicants for a license as a marriage and family therapist in a setting which the supervisor and three or more supervisees meet face-to-face in a regular ongoing fashion;

(3) "Individual supervision," the act or process of watching over the training, work experience, and performance of an applicant for a license as a marriage and family therapist by means of face-to-face contact between the supervisor and not more than two supervisees;

(4) "State or territory," a state of the United States, the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, the United States Virgin Islands, or Guam;

(5) "Supervisor," a licensed marriage and family therapist or the equivalent as determined by the board.
