20:71:01:01. Definitions. Terms used in this article mean:

- (1) "Advisory committee," the Marriage and Family Therapist's Advisory committee appointed pursuant to SDCL 36-33-3;
 - (2) "Board," the Board of Counselor Examiners as defined in SDCL 36-33-2;
- (3) "Group supervision," the act or process of watching over the training, work experience, and performance of applicants for a license as a marriage and family therapist in a setting which the supervisor and not more than six applicants meet face-to-face in a regular ongoing fashion;
- (4) "Individual supervision," the act or process of watching over the training, work experience, and performance of an applicant for a license as a marriage and family therapist by means of face-to-face contact between the supervisor and not more than two applicants;
- (5) "South Dakota Association for Marriage and Family Therapy," a statewide nonprofit organization which has a state charter from the American Association for Marriage and Family Therapy;
- (6) "State or territory," a state of the United States, the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, the United States Virgin Islands, or Guam;
- (7) "Supervisor," a licensed marriage and family therapist or the equivalent as determined by the board.
