

20:62:02:07. Reinstatement of lapsed licenses. A licensee who fails to renew the license may be reinstated by filing a written explanation for failure to renew with the Board of Nursing. The applicant for reinstatement of licensure must provide written evidence of current certification as set forth by subdivision 20:62:02:02(2). The licensee must submit an affidavit that the applicant has committed no act of misconduct as set forth by SDCL 36-9A-29 and 36-9A-30, and the fees required by subdivision 20:62:01:11(4). If the licensee intends to perform the overlapping scope of advanced practice nursing and medical functions set forth in SDCL 36-9A-12 and 36-9A-13, the applicant must also submit a collaborative agreement pursuant to § 20:62:03:06.
