

44:12:01:13. Tattoo artist -- Patrons restricted -- Notice posted. A tattoo artist may not tattoo a patron without first obtaining a signed consent. A tattoo artist may not tattoo a patron with evident skin lesion or skin infection or who is known or suspected to have an infectious or contagious disease in a communicable stage. No tattoo artist may tattoo a patron who is under the influence of alcohol or other mind-altering drugs.

A minor may not be tattooed unless the minor's parents or legal guardian have signed a consent form authorizing the tattoo.

A tattoo artist shall conspicuously post a notice stating that it is illegal to tattoo any person under the age of 18 without the parents' or legal guardian's signed consent.
