GOVERNMENT OPERATIONS AND AUDIT COMMITTEE TO MEET

PIERRE – The Legislature’s Government Operations and Audit Committee will hold the third meeting of the 2018 interim on July 24, 2018. The meeting will begin at 8:30 a.m. (CT) in Room 362 of the State Capitol in Pierre, South Dakota.

The Government Operations and Audit Committee, chaired by Representative Jean Hunhoff (R-Yankton) and Vice-Chair Senator Deb Peters (R-Hartford), will review performance management indicators for the following agencies: Bureau of Administration, Department of Public Safety, Department of Tribal Relations, Board of Regents, and Department of Corrections.

The Bureau of Administration will present information about State office space management procedures. The South Dakota High School Activities Association will present their 2017 annual report. The Board of Regents will present the financial reports for the University Centers. The Department of Corrections will review juvenile corrections reports. The Auditor General and the Bureau of Human Resources will report on compiled authorizations to derive a direct benefit from a contract. The Committee will discuss how to obtain information regarding grant outcomes. The full agenda for the meeting is available on the LRC website: sdlegislature.gov. The meeting is open to the public.

In addition to Chair Representative Hunhoff and Vice-Chair Senator Peters, committee members include Senators Justin Cronin (R-Gettysburg), Brock Greenfield (R-Clark), Neal Tapio (R-Watertown), Billie Sutton (D-Burke); and Representatives David Anderson (R-Hudson), Hugh Bartels (R-Watertown), Wayne Steinhauer (R-Hartford), and Susan Wismer (D-Britton).
