GOVERNMENT OPERATIONS AND AUDIT COMMITTEE TO MEET

PIERRE – The Legislature’s Government Operations and Audit Committee will hold the sixth meeting of the 2019 interim on September 18, 2019. The meeting will begin at 8:00 a.m. (CT) in Room 414 of the State Capitol in Pierre, South Dakota with an additional digital data network location in Room FADM-145 at the Community College for Sioux Falls.

The Government Operations and Audit Committee, Chaired by Senator Ryan Maher (R-Isabel) and Vice Chair Representative Sue Peterson (R-Sioux Falls), will review annual reports from the South Dakota Board of Technical Education, the Department of Public Safety – South Dakota 911 Coordination Board, and the South Dakota Housing Development Authority – Housing Opportunity Fund. The Department of Tourism will present their revised performance management indicators. The Auditor General will provide the report of compiled annual disclosures and authorizations to derive a direct benefit from contracts. The Department of Legislative Audit will provide the Government Operations and Audit Committee Blue Book of Other Funds for fiscal year 2019. The meeting is open to the public.

In addition to Chair Senator Maher and Vice Chair Representative Sue Peterson, committee members include Senators Arthur Rusch (R-Vermillion), John Wiik (R-Big Stone City), Susan Wismer (D-Britton) and Representatives Steven Haugaard (R-Sioux Falls), Chris Karr (R-Sioux Falls), Isaac Latterell (R-Tea), and Shawn Bordeaux (D-Mission).
