Membership Changes Coming to Government Operations and Audit Committees

PIERRE – Senator Brock Greenfield, President Pro Tempore, has announced changes to the membership and leadership of the Senate Government Operations and Audit Committee following the recent resignation of Senator Justin Cronin of Gettysburg from the South Dakota Senate.

Senator John Wiik (R-Big Stone City) has been named as vice chair of the Senate standing committee. Filling Cronin's vacancy as a member of both the standing committee and the Interim Government Operations and Audit Committee will be Senator Jack Kolbeck (R-Sioux Falls).

Representative John Lake (R-Gettysburg) was appointed by Governor Noem on September 5, 2019, to take Cronin's place in the South Dakota Senate. An appointment is pending for Lake's position in the South Dakota House of Representatives.
