## Deadline Nears for 2021 Legislative Intern Applications

**PIERRE** – October 9, 2020 is the deadline for college or university students to file applications with the Legislative Research Council to serve as legislative interns for the 2021 Legislative Session.

Twenty-two intern positions are available and students from all majors are encouraged to apply. This year, the program is also being opened to recent college graduates. Interns are needed to serve both parties, and work with the legislative leadership as well as assist legislators with bill briefs, constituent services, and other legislative tasks.

Students will receive \$4,750 in compensation for their services and may also receive college credits for their internship. The 96th South Dakota Legislative Session runs from January 12, 2021 to March 29, 2021 with a recess from March 12-26.

Intern applicants must provide an unofficial copy of their college transcript and three letters of recommendation with their application. Additional information on the internship program including an application can be found on the Legislative Research Council's [website](#).
