REDEFINE ACUTE MENTAL HEALTH HOSPITALIZATION LEGISLATIVE INTERIM TASK FORCE TO MEET

PIERRE – Senate Concurrent Resolution 2, passed during the 2019 Legislative Session, included a task force to redefine acute mental health hospitalizations in the areas of short, intermediate, and long-term placement, with emphasis on keeping individuals needing placement in the community whenever possible. The task force will hold its first meeting Monday, October 7, 2019, at 9:00 a.m. (CT) in Room 413 of the State Capitol in Pierre, South Dakota.

The Task Force will begin by reviewing the mental health services currently available in South Dakota as well as behavioral health community care options as alternatives to hospitalization. Discussion will also focus on the community mental health care system in the state and use of a regionalization approach to address treatment needs. The meeting is open to the public, and public testimony will be taken in the afternoon. The agenda is available [online](#).
