## AGRICULTURAL LAND ASSESSMENT IMPLEMENTATION AND OVERSIGHT ADVISORY TASK FORCE TO MEET

**PIERRE** – The Agricultural Land Assessment Implementation and Oversight Advisory Task Force, chaired by Senator Gary Cammack (R-Union Center), will hold its first meeting of the 2020 Interim on Friday, October 23, 2020, beginning at 9:00 a.m. (CT). The meeting will be conducted via electronic conference with limited physical access in Room 414 of the State Capitol in Pierre, South Dakota. In accordance with COVID-19 guidance, in-person attendees are encouraged to wear face coverings and remain at least six feet apart.

Members will receive an update from the Department of Revenue that includes a presentation of the extra tools in the new soil tables, an explanation of how the landowner request form works, and a report on the educational efforts delivered to counties this summer.
