STATE-TRIBAL RELATIONS LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE TO MEET

PIERRE – The State-Tribal Relations Interim Legislative Committee, chaired by Representative Shawn Bordeaux (D-Mission), will hold its fourth meeting of the 2020 interim on Thursday October 22, 2020, beginning at 1 p.m. (CT). The meeting is being conducted via electronic conference with limited physical access in Room 413 of the State Capitol in Pierre, South Dakota. In accordance with COVID-19 guidance, in-person attendees should be spaced at least six feet apart and are encouraged to wear face coverings. At the meeting, U.S. Senator Mike Rounds and U.S. Representative Dusty Johnson will address the members, and the committee will discuss and hear testimony on various tribal issues, including reestablishing the Office of Indian Education within the Department of Education, COVID-19 related issues in state prisons, and charter school legislation.
