Department of Transportation: (October 5, 2020) intends to amend rules change the speed limit on U.S. Highway 212 in and around LaPlant from 55 miles per hour to 45 miles per hour; extend the 45 miles per hour speed zone on U.S. Highway 18 west of West Street in Canton; and initiate a 50 mile per hour speed zone on State Trunk Highway 20 in Spink County, beginning .52 mile west of U.S. Highway 281, then east .58 mile. The general authority for these rules, as cited by the department, is SDCL 32-25-7 and 32-25-7.1.

A public hearing will be held October 29, 2020, at 9:00 a.m. CT in the Commission Room of the Becker Hansen Building, 700 East Broadway Avenue, Pierre, South Dakota.
