Department of Education: South Dakota Board of Education Standards:

(December 14, 2018) intends to amend rules to remove the requirement for state approval of school-created course equivalency exams and allow local schools to determine how to transcribe credit earned by course equivalency exams. The general authority for these rules, as cited by the board, is SDCL §§ 13-1-12.1 and 13-3-47.

A public hearing will be held at the MacKay Building, First Floor, Library Commons, 800 Governors Drive, Pierre, South Dakota, on January 28, 2019, at 10:00 a.m. CT. Department of Game, Fish and Parks:

(December 14, 2018) intends to amend or establish rules to restrict applicants for East River, West River, Black Hills or Muzzleloader deer hunting seasons to submitting no more than one license application for the combined drawing for these seasons; establish a drawing structure in which applicants would need to choose a preferred license in either the special buck drawing or the first combined drawing of the East River, West River, Black Hills or Muzzleloader deer hunting seasons; and allow applicants a choice to use preference points for leftover licenses in the first three combined deer drawings. The general authority for these rules, as cited by the department, is SDCL §§ 41-2-18 and 41-6-21.

A public hearing will be held at the Red Rosa Convention Center, 808 West Sioux Avenue, Pierre, South Dakota, on January 3, 2019, at 2:00 p.m. CT. Copies of the rules may be obtained without charge from and written comments sent to the Secretary of the Department of Game, Fish and Parks, Foss Building, 523 E. Capitol, Pierre, SD 57501.
