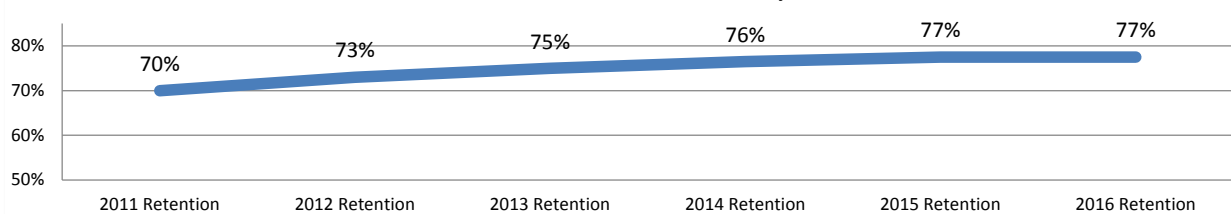

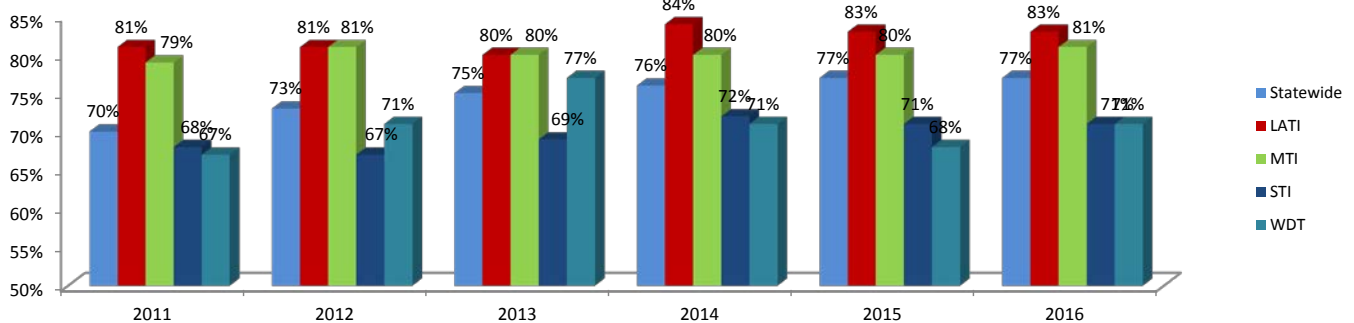

However, entering, financial-aid eligible students at WDT are all placed in a program, rather than a program prep category
