

ALL Employers Face this Challenge.

- Unemployment Rate = 2.8%
- # of Unemployed/Job Opening = 0.34
- Total Job Openings in SD = 16,147
- SD Labor Force Participation Rate = 68.1%
- Employment Participation Rate for 16-19 year olds = 37.8%
- SD #1 for Multiple Job Holders = 9.1%

South Dakota: #1 State for Inbound Migration


- United Van Lines called South Dakota the nation's "Top Moving Destination."
 - People moved for job (60%) and family (24%).
 - Demographic: 18-34 and 45-54 made up 30% each of inbound migration.

Retirees Moving to Mountain and Pacific West

South Dakota narrowly overtakes Oregon, which held the top spot for the previous three years, as the nation's "Top Moving Destination." This is the first time South Dakota has held the no. 1 spot. Vermont inched out Oregon for the no. 2 position, with Oregon rounding out the top three. Those are the results of the [United Van Lines' 40th Annual National Movers Study](#), which tracks customers' state-to-state migration patterns over the past year.


