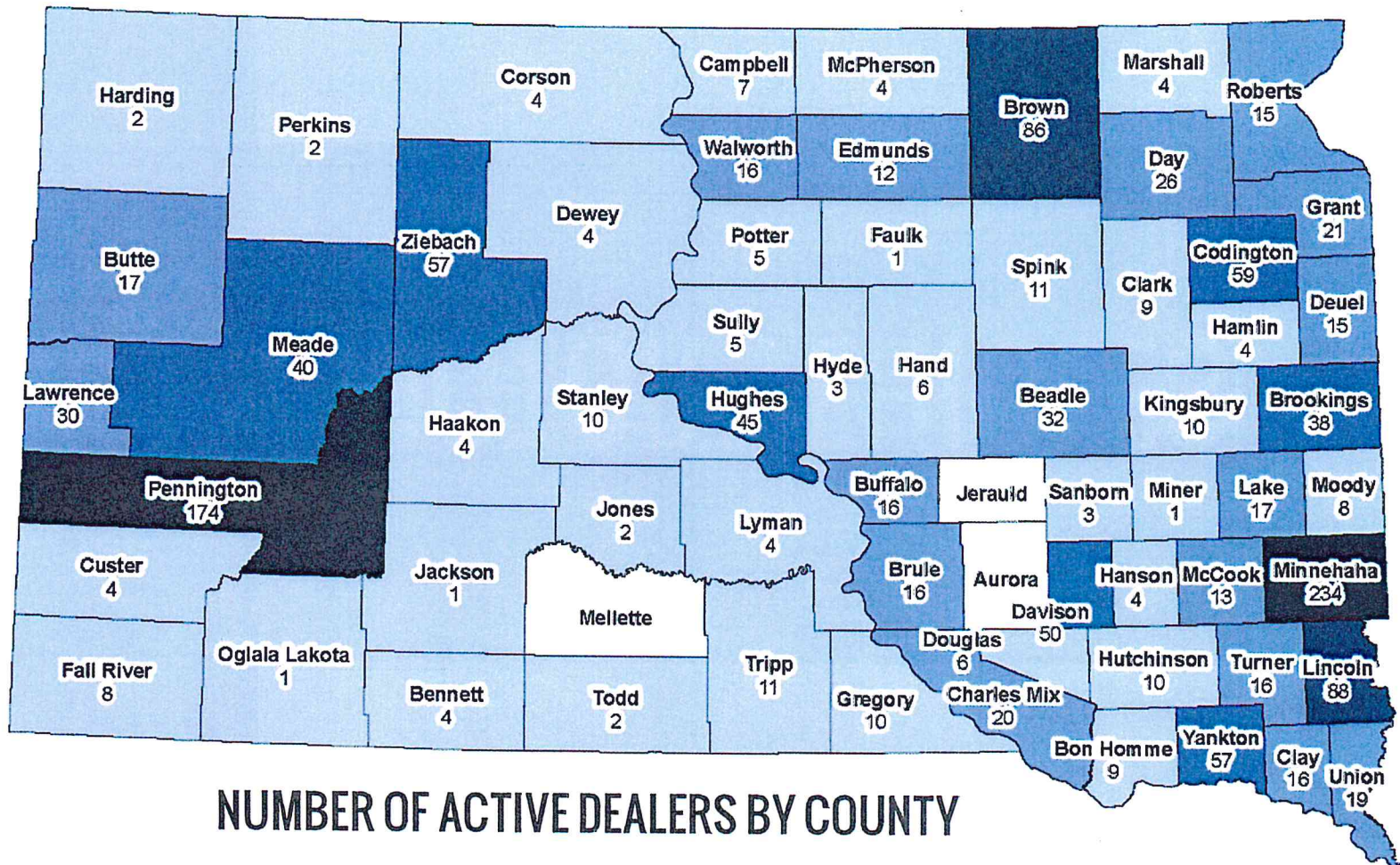

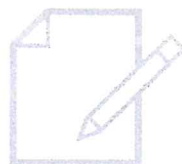

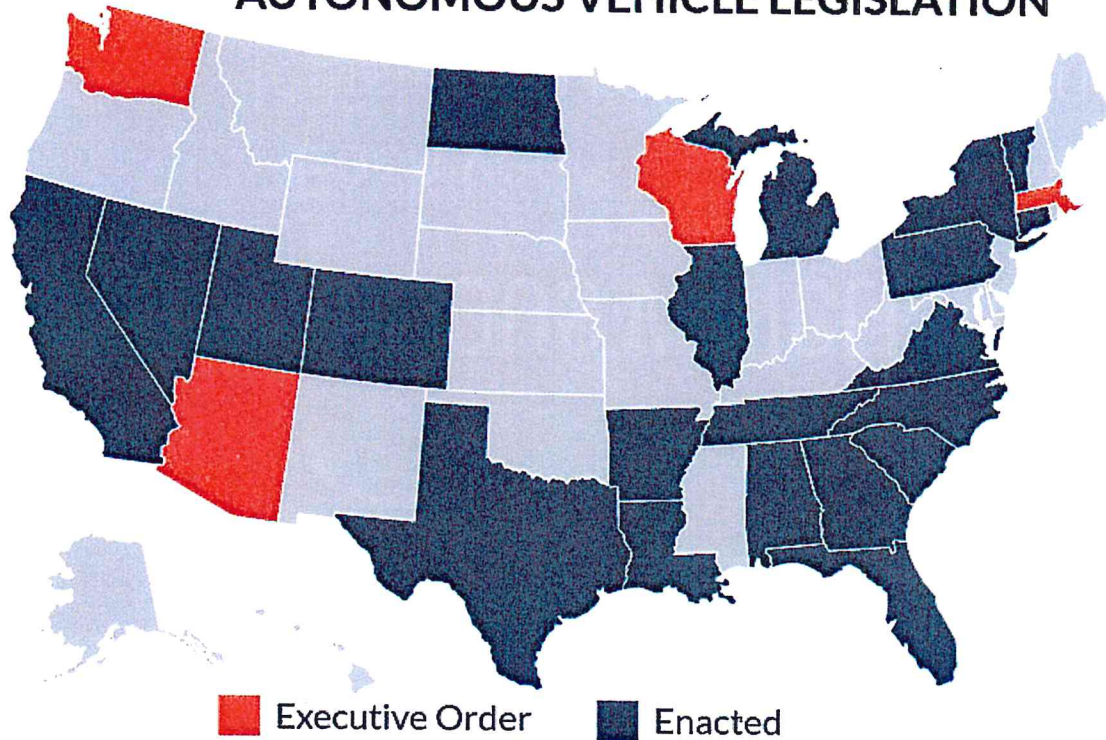
# AUTONOMOUS VEHICLES | SELF-DRIVING VEHICLES

## South Dakota

In addition to the Governor's office, DOT, DPS, and DOR are aware of this trend and will work together for future legislation.

## Nationwide

In 2017, 33 states have introduced legislation.  
Last year, 20 states introduced legislation.

Since 2012, at least 41 states and D.C. have considered legislation related to autonomous vehicles.

21 states have passed legislation related to autonomous vehicles.
