

Breakdown of services


- 64 Residential Treatment





Admissions by race/ origin




Admissions by gender




Safe Solution Admission Sources

Project Recovery

Provides Medication-Assisted Treatment to Rapid City

- Access
 - Walk-ins permitted
 - 5 days a week
 - Wait list less than 24 hours
- Case Management
 - Free medications
 - Provides Hep C treatment
- Telemedicine
 - Same access to any city in the State via Telemedicine
 - Able to assist other institutions via telemedicine within SD.



Project Recovery

Provides Medication-Assisted Treatment to Rapid City

- Costs
 - Free for anyone who meets financial hardship set by Division of Behavioral Health.
 - Services are never denied for lack of payment
- Quality
 - Follows SAMHSA Treatment Protocols
 - Reports data to SAMHSA
 - Evidence-based treatment



Referrals to Project Recovery

- 40 referrals from the Pennington County Jail since March 2019
- 9 referrals from the Care Campus since May 2019
- We make printed material regarding MAT services available at our locations
- We assist in preparing Release-of-Information and Applications for medically-assisted treatment through DSS
- We continually provide medical care while individuals are housed at the Jail or the Care Campus
