1 A JOINT RESOLUTION, Rescinding House Joint Resolutions calling for a constitutional  
2 convention, or convention of the states, for the purpose of amending the Constitution of the  
3 United States.

4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF SOUTH  
5 DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

6 WHEREAS, the Legislature of the State of South Dakota, in 1907, adopted House Joint  
7 Resolution 2; in 1909, adopted House Joint Resolutions 5 and 7; and in 1971, adopted House  
8 Joint Resolution 503, making formal application to Congress to call an Article V constitutional  
9 convention for the purpose of altering the Constitution of the United States of America:

10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the House of Representatives of the  
11 Ninety-Fourth Legislature of the State of South Dakota, the Senate concurring therein, that  
12 House Joint Resolution 2, adopted in 1907; House Joint Resolutions 5 and 7, adopted in 1909;  
13 and House Joint Resolution 503, adopted in 1971, of the Legislature of the State of South  
14 Dakota, be rescinded; and

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the secretary of state transmit copies of this resolution



1 to the President of the United States, the Speaker and Clerk of the United States House of  
2 Representatives, the President and Secretary of the United States Senate, the members of the  
3 South Dakota congressional delegation, and the Governor of the State of South Dakota, attesting  
4 the adoption of this resolution by the Legislature of the State of South Dakota.
