1-18-2007	Environment and Natural Resources: Board of Minerals and Environment	Adopt rules to identify the requirements an applicant must meet to obtain a state mine permit for and to operate an in situ leach mine; 33 SDR 117.
1-22-2007	Education: Board of Education	Amend rules to allow for students taking courses in a non-public educational program to transfer these into a public school; establish procedures for payment and timelines for those teachers obtaining National Board Certification procedures; and align the state rules with national standards for school buses in South Dakota; 33 SDR 123.
1-25-2007	Transportation	Amend a speed zone in Yankton County on South Dakota Highway 52 west of Yankton to remove the existing 40 mile per hour speed zone west of town and to add a new 40 mile per hour speed zone at the western edge of town; 33 SDR 105.
