FILINGS IN THE LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH COUNCIL'S OFFICE:

NOTICES:

The **Department of Social Services** intends to make changes to the South Dakota Medicaid State Plan regarding community health worker services. The proposed State Plan Amendment (SPA) establishes coverage criteria and a reimbursement methodology for these services. The SPA amends Supplement to Attachment 3.1-A page 26 and adds 26b to the South Dakota Medicaid State Plan and amends Attachment 4.19-B Introduction page 1 and page 26. The Department intends to make this SPA effective April 1, 2019 and estimates there will be a \$257,200.62 fiscal impact in Federal Fiscal Year 2019 and an impact of \$514,427.43 in Federal Fiscal Year 2020. FILINGS IN THE SECRETARY OF STATE'S OFFICE:

Executive Order:

The Governor has signed **Executive Order 2019-01**, dated January 14, 2019. Article IV, Section 8 of the constitution of the state of South Dakota gives the Governor the authority to reorganize offices, boards, commissions, agencies and instrumentalities as she considers necessary for efficient administration. This executive order transfers the Office of Indian Education in the Department of Education to the Department of Tribal Relations and aligns the functions of the Indian Education Advisory Council with the Department of Tribal Relations. It also transfers from the Department of Agriculture to the Governor's Office of Economic Development the Value Added Finance Authority, Rural Rehabilitation Assets and Funds, Farm Link Program, and South Dakota Certified Beef Program.
