The Governor has signed **Executive Order 2016-03** dated March 10, 2016. This order declares that the offices of state government, within the executive branch, shall be administratively closed for the afternoon of Good Friday, March 25, 2016.

### **REMINDER OF HEARINGS SCHEDULED**

<b>3-16-2016</b>	<b>Department of Revenue: SD Commission on Gaming:</b> Amend Gaming rules to add a new version of blackjack (Bonus Spin Counts Kustom Blackjack) to the list of authorized blackjack games; add new pay tables and revise the rules in accordance with the new pay tables for Dead Man's Hand Blackjack; add a variation of the play of blackjack known as Bonus Spin Counts Kustom Blackjack; amend a rule The Play – Ultimate Texas Hold'em to recognize that bets cannot exceed \$1,000 bet limit; and amend a Control Program Requirements rule to change the number of recalls for play history from two to ten games; 42 SDR 123, February 29, 2016.
<b>3-28-2016</b>	<b>Public Utilities Commission</b> Adopt rules to set forth specific measurement and testing procedures that an electric utility must follow when the utility tests a dairy for stray voltage or current; 42 SDR 123, February 29, 2016.
