- [Executive Order 2020-13](#), dated April 6, 2020, providing for a "stay at home" order for vulnerable individuals over the age of 65 and those deemed high risk for the coronavirus in Minnehaha and Lincoln Counties. The order will remain in effect through April 27, 2020.
- [Executive Order 2020-14](#), dated April 7, 2020, suspending certain regulations regarding teacher evaluations, meetings conducted by public bodies, and parole violations.
- [Executive Order 2020-15](#), dated April 9, 2020, extending the expiration date of the initial State of Emergency declaration signed March 13, 2020, from April 12, 2020, to May 31, 2020.
