Staff Announcement

Executive Orders

Governor Noem has signed the following Executive Orders:

- [Executive Order 2020-20](#), dated April 28, 2020, putting into effect the state's "Back to Normal Plan" in response to the COVID-19 pandemic.
- [Executive Order 2020-21](#), dated April 30, 2020, suspending regulations related to vehicle titling, registration, and renewal, along with the one-year probation requirement for law enforcement officers and 911 telecommunicators to complete their Academy course.
- [Executive Order 2020-22](#), dated May 1, 2020, providing authority to cabinet secretaries and bureau commissioners to have all employees return to their offices, allowing administrative leave for those who cannot come in and cannot work remotely, and allowing for approved out-of-state work-related travel. It rescinds Executive Order 2020-09 and is effective through May 31, 2020.

5-7-2020	<u>Department of Game, Fish and Parks</u> : Amend rules to make an allowance for an additional single-tag "antlerless any deer" license that would be distributed amongst all municipal archery deer hunting units; create new units for municipal archery deer hunting within city limits of certain cities; modify the start date for the Lacreek National Refuge and Sand Lake National Wildlife Refuge archery deer seasons; modify the age requirement for who would qualify for the youth waterfowl hunting season; modify the dates from "five consecutive days beginning on the first Saturday of October" to "9 consecutive days beginning 21 days prior to the third Saturday of October" for the special youth pheasant hunting season; limit the harvest of flathead catfish 20 inches or longer to one fish as part of the daily limit; and remove the River Otter from the list of threatened mammals; 46 SDR 119, April 20, 2020.
5-7-2020	<u>South Dakota Board of Accountancy (Department of Labor & Regulation)</u> : Amend rules to update references and language to allow for CPA exam candidates to have continuous testing; 46 SDR 116, April 14, 2020.
5-7-2020	<u>South Dakota State Library Board (Department of Education)</u> : Amend rules to update fees charged to library users who damage or lose state library materials; 46 SDR 105, March 2, 2020.
5-11-2020	<u>South Dakota Board of Education Standards (Department of Education)</u> : Amend rules to accurately reflect the federal Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) rules amended by Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) and correct the definition of preschool age and preschool program to align with the IDEA preschool age; 46 SDR 97, February 6, 2020.
5-19-2020	<u>South Dakota Division of Insurance (Department of Labor and Regulation)</u> : Amend rules to update the sources referenced in rule; incorporate 2020 Medicare Supplement coverage amounts set by the federal government; and clarify the information required for insurance companies to complete the Corporate Governance Annual Disclosure provided by the passage of House Bill 1017 during the 2020 Legislative Session; 46 SDR 122, April 27, 2020.
5-19-2020	<u>Department of Social Services</u> : Amend rules to eliminate the current disqualification for TANF assistance for individuals with felony drug convictions, pursuant to the passage of Senate Bill 96 during the 2020 Legislative Session; 46 SDR 122, April 27, 2020.
5-28-2020	<u>Department of Transportation</u> : Amend rules to revise the dates for temporary reduced speed limits on Interstate Highway 90 between Sturgis and Rapid City, State Trunk Highway 34 in Sturgis, and State Trunk Highway 79 immediately north of its intersection with State Trunk Highway 34 in Meade County; 46 SDR 122, April 27, 2020.
6-19-2020	<u>South Dakota State Historical Society (Department of Education)</u> : Amend rules to set standard fees for services provided by the State Historical Society; 46 SDR 93, January 27, 2020.
