The **South Dakota Commission on Gaming** has filed with the Legislative Research Council a Declaratory Ruling petitioned by Blue Sky Gaming DBA Tin Lizzie regarding whether fire doors or walls between two buildings could be removed and replaced with water curtains; if nonseparation walls in buildings could be removed; and if a wall between two buildings could be removed, eliminating one building for gaming purposes.

5-15-2019	Department of Education: South Dakota Board of Technical Education: Amend rules to update the yearly facility fund and National Guard tuition benefit fund set-asides from the total state appropriation; and update the yearly per student allocation appropriated by the South Dakota Legislature in the postsecondary technical institute funding formula; 45 SDR 136, April 29, 2019.
5-20-2019	Department of Education: South Dakota Board of Education Standards: Amend rules to update language to reflect industry standards; correct references to national program standards where applicable; and align terminology and requirements with educator certification rules updated; 45 SDR 124, April 1, 2019.
5-23-2019	Department of Transportation: Amend the definitions section of its rules concerning state highway fund loans for local governments to include townships; 45 SDR 137, April 29, 2019.
