Department of Health: (June 10, 2020) intends to amend rules to update the form used by a physician to comply with the requirements of SDCL 34-23A-10.1 (1). The general authority for these rules, as cited by the department, is SDCL 34-23A-10.5.

6-19-2020	South Dakota Cosmetology Commission (Department of Labor and Regulation): Amend rules to remove reference to the date fee increases become effective; remove the requirement to provide proof of high school graduation for licensure; remove the requirement for reciprocity applicants to take a hands-on practical examination; revise the number of hours reciprocity applicants can earn through work experience; revise the number of hours foreign-educated applicants must complete in a commission-approved school; reference the blood exposure rules in the rule that requires said rules to be in or near the first aid kit; and establish a rule to allow acceptance of related coursework completed at an institution not teaching the practices of cosmetology, nail technology, or esthetics; 46 SDR 137, May 26, 2020.
