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### Notice of Proposed Rules

**Department of Human Services:** (July 6, 2020) intends to amend rules to transfer the chapter concerning Adult Protective Services from the Department of Social Services to the Department of Human Services. The general authority for these rules, as cited by the department, is SDCL 1-36A-26 and 28-1-45.

A public hearing will be held telephonically on July 28, 2020, at 9:00 a.m. CT. Interested parties may attend by calling 1-866-410-8397 and using conference code 5969258425#. Copies of the proposed rules may be obtained without charge from and written comments sent to Beverly Katz, Department of Human Services, c/o 500 E. Capitol Avenue, Pierre, South Dakota 57501. Copies of the proposed rules are also available online at <http://rules.sd.gov>. The comment period will close on August 7, 2020. This hearing is being held in a physically accessible location. Persons with special needs for which the department can make arrangements may call (605) 773-5990 at least 48 hours before the public hearing.

### Notices

The **Department of Social Services** intends to make changes to the South Dakota Medicaid State Plan to allow continued flexibility in the event the federal government does not extend the declared COVID-19 public health emergency. The proposed State Plan Amendment (SPA) removes the face-to-face requirement for Community Mental Health Center providers and amends pages 27-30 of the Supplement 1 to Attachment 3.1-A. The face-to-face requirements are currently suspended by Section 7.4 of the state plan. However, Section 7.4 of the state plan will be invalid at the end of the declared public health emergency, which is currently set to end on July 25, 2020. The department intends to make this SPA effective July 21, 2020 and estimates it will have no fiscal impact in Federal Fiscal Years 2020 and 2021.

Executive Orders

Governor Noem has signed [Executive Order 2020-30](#) in response to the state's on-going COVID-19 efforts. The Order, dated July 7, 2020, restates the COVID-19 emergency period to be from July 1 to December 30 for purposes of federal law related to coronavirus funding. Some previously suspended regulations will again become enforceable including those pertaining to the titling and registration of motor vehicles and manufactured homes, and driver's license renewal.

<b>7-15-2020</b>	<a href="#">South Dakota Board of Massage Therapy (Department of Health)</a> : Amend rules to update provisions related to inactive licenses and CEU credits and establish a fee for late renewals; 47 SDR 1, July 6, 2020.
<b>7-16-2020</b>	<a href="#">Department of Game, Fish and Parks</a> : Amend rules to not require a park entrance license to be purchased for any enrolled Yankton Sioux tribal member and their family member to enter North Point Recreation Area, Fort Randall South Shore Recreation Area, Randall Creek Recreation Area, and Fort Randall Spillway Lakeside Use Area; eliminate the administrative fee required for lost or destroyed licenses, permits or game tags; establish a fee for nonresident landowner-on-own-land licenses; reduce the number of resident single tag fall turkey license while increasing the number of resident double tag licenses for Prairie Units; adjust the number of turkey licenses available in the Black Hills; close certain Prairie Units; establish a resident river otter trapping season from November 1 through December 31; and eliminate unnecessary language, amend form and style, update authorities, and arrange rules to be consistent and concise; 46 SDR 151, June 29, 2020.
<b>7-20-2020</b>	<a href="#">Department of Health</a> : Amend rules to update the form used by a physician to comply with the requirements of SDCL 34-23A-10.1 (1); 46 SDR 146, June 15, 2020.
<b>7-23-2020</b>	<a href="#">Department of Transportation</a> : Amend rules to eliminate a limited speed zone on State Trunk Highway 50 west of Wagner; redefine the starting point of the speed zones on State Trunk Highway 46 in and around Wagner; shorten the current 35 miles per hour speed zone and introduce a 45 miles per hour speed zone on each end of the 35 miles per hour speed zone on U.S. Highway 16 adjacent to Jewel Cave National Monument; correct the starting point references for the 50 miles per hour speed zone on U.S. Highway 212 in Faulkton; extend the 45 miles per hour speed limit on U.S. Highway 14 in Highmore; extend the 45 miles per hour speed zone on South Dakota Highway 11 west of Canton; and amend rules governing the mowing of state trunk highway rights-of-way; 47 SDR 1, July 6, 2020.
