**NOTICES OF PROPOSED RULES:** (The date in parentheses is the date the rules were filed in the Legislative Research Council.)

***Department of Game, Fish and Parks:***

(September 1, 2005) intends to repeal the Cow Creek State Waterfowl Refuge on the Missouri River and amend the West River Prairie Deer Season in Gregory and Mellette Counties. The general authority for these rules, as cited by the department, is SDCL 41-2-18 and 41-6-21.

A public hearing will be held at Jo Dean's Steak House & Lounge, 2809 Broadway Avenue (North Highway 81), Yankton, South Dakota, on October 6, 2005, at 2:00 p.m. Copies of the proposed rules may be obtained from and written comments sent to John L. The Governor has signed **Executive Order 2005-10** dated September 2, 2005, which exempts motor carriers and drivers transporting gasoline, diesel fuel and jet fuel in response to transportation needs arising from the hurricane disaster from the requirements of SDCL 49-28A-3. The executive order expires at midnight, September 14, 2005.
