[South Dakota State Board of Dentistry \(Department of Health\)](#): (September 6, 2019) intends to amend rules to incorporate the Integrated National Board Dental Examination; streamline and update requirements regarding clinical competency examinations; update supervision levels; update the duties and procedures performed by dental assistants and registered dental assistants; update registered dental assistant registration requirements and training program criteria; remove redundant regulations and obsolete provisions, and update references; update student exemption to registration; and update continuing education requirements applicable to registered dental assistants. The general authority for these rules, as cited by the board, is SDCL 36-6A-14, 36-6A-33, 36-6A-41, 36-6A-42, 36-6A-44, 36-6A-44.2, 36-6A-50, and 36-6A-55.

A public hearing will be held at the Kneip Building, Board Room C, 700 Governors Drive, Pierre, South Dakota, on October 18, 2019, at 10:00 a.m. CT.
